Hook Hill Lane (D3681) Woking
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 01 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Hook Hill Lane (D3681) Woking that is comprised within Hook Hill Railway Bridge and for a distance of 55 metres either side. **Alternative Route** – (D3681) Hook Hill Lane, (D3680) Hook Heath Road, (D3680) Saunders Lane, (D3680) Smarts Heath Road and (D3681) Hook Hill Lane or this route in reverse. This Order is required to facilitate repairs to the access track works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Dyer & Butler. These works are anticipated to be completed over 12 days between the hours of 7am and 4pm within 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 20 March 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents will be maintained at all times. Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to maintain vehicular access through the closure for emergency services and all vehicular traffic will be required to use the signed diversion route.
