

PREFACE

After F J Field had completed his book "An Armorial for Cumberland" in 1937, he began to make notes for a proposed armorial for Surrey, where he was then living, and when he joined the army he left these notes entitled "Surrey Coats of Arms" in the custody of his friend the Rev. (later Canon) R C Tait, who kept them carefully after Field's death in the battle of El Alamein.

In September 1977 Canon Tait sent the typescript of the notes to my friend Roy Hudleston, expressing the hope that he might know someone who could make use of them. Roy passed them to me, and I have thought that it would be a fitting tribute to Field and his pioneer work to put his notes into order and to add to them from the written sources available to me here in the North of England. I am acutely conscious of the fact that I have been able to do little more than scratch the surface of what is there to record of the arms borne by families, individuals and institutions in Surrey, and that a lifetime's work would be need to do the subject justice. In particular, I have not yet had the opportunity of visiting any churches or houses in Surrey. I hope that I may be able to do this when I retire, but in the meantime I am equally aware of the passage of time. I shall, therefore, deposit the results of my and Field's researches into the written sources into the Surrey Record office and hope that, if it is not possible for me to continue these in Surrey itself, the task may be undertaken some day by someone younger and more active.

I have made no attempt to distinguish between Field's original entries and my later ones, for I think that our different styles of writing taken in conjunction with the two separate lists of authorities quoted will make the distinction clear. All footnotes are mine unless specifically attributed to Field.

I should like to take this opportunity of thanking my good friend Roy Hudleston, companion of so many happy days in the North of England, for the help and encouragement he has so freely and willingly given me. I am also very grateful to my secretary, Miss J Hodson, for all her help, especially in tying the manuscript.
