

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**Shere Road (D258) West Horsley**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 16 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Shere Road (D258) West Horsley as extends from its junction at the roundabout with (A246) Epsom Road to its junction with (D257) Fullers Farm Road; and
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Shere Road (D258) West Horsley Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” in so far as it affects that length of road described in part (a).

Alternative Route – Shere Road; Combe Lane; Green Dene; and (A246) Guildford Road/Epsom Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow overhead cabling and/or tree trimming and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Freeflow TM within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 weeks between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 14 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All through traffic will be required to use the signed diversion route.
