

Surrey County Council  
Amendments to Waiting and Loading Restrictions  
And On-Street Parking Places in the Borough of Woking

Surrey County Council propose to make “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Amendment of Waiting, Loading and Unloading Prohibition and On-Street Parking Places Orders) (Amendment No.4) Order 202- “, pursuant to Sections 1, 2, 4, 14, 32, 35, 36 and 45 to 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The purpose and effect of which is to amend the following Orders: -

- (1) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and Restriction) Order 2019
- (2) The Surrey County Council Woking Controlled Parking Zone (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019
- (3) The Surrey County Council West Byfleet Controlled Parking Zone in the Borough of Woking (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019
- (4) The Surrey County Council Brookwood Controlled Parking Zone in the Borough of Woking (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019
- (5) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) Electric Vehicle Parking Places Order 2021
- (6) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2019

So as to: -

- (a) Prohibit waiting by vehicles in certain lengths of the roads specified in the First Schedule to this Notice, on the days and at the times indicated in the said Schedule; Exemptions for loading on and unloading from vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining the lengths of roads referred to in the First Schedule, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme, will apply to the afore-mentioned restrictions;

- (b) Introduce a 1 hour no return within 2 hours 8.30am – 6pm Monday – Saturday waiting restriction on the parking bay outside properties 87 – 93 High Street, Horsell
- (c) Provide an extension to the parking bay on the eastern side of Horsell Park to a total length of 25 metres (Monday-Friday 9.30am-11.30am permit holders or voucher parking limited to 1 hour).
- (d) Provide an extension of 5 metres to each of the parking bays outside No.32, No.33 and No.41 De Lara Way (Monday-Friday 9.30am-11.30am permit holders or voucher parking limited to 1 hour).
- (e) Mabel Street, Wilfred Street and Bridge Barn Lane will be moved from Zone 5 to Zone 3 of the Woking CPZ so that the waiting restrictions operating Monday-Friday 9.30-11.30am shall instead operate Monday-Saturday 8.30am-6pm (subject to the provisions below)
- (f) Revoke the 20 minute no return within 1 hour Monday to Saturday 8.30am – 6.00pm parking restriction from a parking bay in Wilfred Street, to be replaced with Monday - Saturday 8.30am-6.00pm Permit Holders or Voucher Parking limited to 3 hours
- (g) Introduce a restriction of Area 3 permit holders only or 20 minutes no return within 1 hour Monday to Saturday 8.30am – 6pm to the three dual use parking places on Bridge Barn Lane
- (h) Provide a disabled persons' parking place in Brooklyn Close, operational at all times without limit of time
- (i) Revoke the Woking CPZ Zone 4 parking restrictions of Monday-Friday 9.30am-11.30am Permit Holders or Voucher Parking 1hr limit from the parking bays along Woodham Road between Kettlewell Hill and Carlton Road so that the bays shall be unrestricted, save for the bay on the south side outside No.4 (shown on the TRO but not installed) replaced by a Monday-Friday 9.30-11.30am waiting restriction.
- (j) Provide an unrestricted parking bay in Hopfield Avenue, Byfleet
- (k) Introduce a limited waiting period of 2 hours no return with 1 hour Monday – Saturday 8.30am – 6pm to the parking places outside of No's 1-5 Marshalls Parade, Lovelace Drive; and No's 6-9 Marshalls Parade, Coldharbour Road, Pyrford
- (l) Provide that there be a restriction from loading on and unloading from vehicles at any time in certain lengths of Monument Road and Princess Road, Maybury, subject to

the usual exceptions, e. g. for works on or adjoining the said lengths of roads, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for emergency service vehicles etc

- (m) Revoke such loading and unloading restrictions (1) at any time in Lock Way, Woking; and (2) Monday- Friday 8.30-9.30am and 4.30-6pm in parts of Church Street East, Stanley Road, Walton Road and Maybury Road, Woking
- (n) Introduce such electric vehicle on-street parking places in certain lengths of the roads specified in the *Second* Schedule to this Notice, to be used at the times and on the days specified therein by electric vehicles or hybrid vehicles for the purpose of charging the said vehicle by use of the electric charging post installed in respect of that parking place.
- (o) Introduce such electric vehicle on-street parking places with an additional charge for parking in certain lengths of the roads specified in the *Third* Schedule to this Notice, to be used at the times and on the days and subject to the fee specified therein by electric vehicles or hybrid vehicles for the purpose of charging the said vehicle by use of the electric charging post installed in respect of that parking place. Subject to an exemption for payment of the fee for parking for vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's blue badge.
- (p) Make certain drafting amendments to the following existing Orders which impose waiting, loading and unloading and parking prohibitions and restrictions in the Borough of Woking, which will not affect the operation of those prohibitions and restrictions:-
  - (1) The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Woking (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019
  - (2) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Consolidation and Revocation of Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Order 2019
  - (3) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in the Borough of Woking) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Order 2019
  - (4) The Surrey County Council (Borough of Woking) Free On-Street Parking Places (Police Vehicles) Order 2019
  - (5) The Surrey County Council (Borough of Woking) (Bus Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2019

- (6) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Consolidation of Loading bays and Revocation) Order 2019
- (7) The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Woking (On-Street Car Club Parking Places) Order 2019

Where a restriction is proposed herein any existing restriction on the same length of road will be revoked, unless otherwise indicated

A copy of the plans showing the lengths of roads to which the Orders relate and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing the Orders may be inspected, free of charge, at
