The Surrey County Council
Effingham Common Road (C43) and The Street (C43) Effingham
Temporary Traffic Management Order 2022

On 13 July 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Effingham Common Road (C43) Effingham as extends from its southern junction with (D646) Leewood Way to its junction at the mini-roundabout with (D265) Orestan Lane and (C43) The Street.

Alternative Route – The Street; A246 Guildford Road; Ockham Road South; Forest Road; Howard Road; and Effingham Common Road;

- (b) prohibit vehicles from waiting, loading, and unloading at any time on both sides of that length of The Street (C43) Effingham as extends from its junction at the mini-roundabout with (D265) Lower Road to its junction with (D266) Chapel Hill.

This Order is required to allow highway improvement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Surrey County Council within the length of road described in sub-paragraph (a) of this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible over 3 weeks within the 12-month period of operation of this Order that commences on 25 July 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed; and the temporary closures and suspensions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.

For sub-paragraph (a) above: Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Due to the nature of the works and for reasons of safety there will be no vehicular access through the works area, all vehicular traffic, including residents and the emergency services will be required to use the signed diversion routes. Access will be maintained to the car park of St Lawrence County Primary School if required and only when safe to do so.

For sub-paragraphs (b) above: Exemptions apply for vehicles when waiting because they are required by law to stop, are obliged to stop in order to prevent an accident or are prevented from proceeding because of circumstances outside the drivers control and in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer will apply when the temporary restrictions are in force. (N.B. Disabled persons displaying a disabled blue badge will not be exempt from the temporary waiting restriction).

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above or accessible only therefrom may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
