D218 Blacksmith Lane and D218 Halfpenny Lane, Chilworth

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 11 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D218 Blacksmith Lane and D218 Halfpenny Lane, Chilworth. This Traffic Order is required to enable UK Power Networks to carry out electrical connection and/or maintenance works in the length of D218 Blacksmith Lane, Chilworth that extends from its junction with A248 Dorking Road, for a distance of 20m. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 7am and 7pm, within 2 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 14 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated to be required for 24 hours each day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times via the vehicular diversion route: - Blacksmith Lane, Halfpenny Lane, White Lane, Guildford Lane, Chilworth Road, Dorking Road and Blacksmith Lane.
