D274 Raikes Lane, Abinger Hammer

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 18 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: - 1. Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D274 Raikes Lane, Abinger Hammer. 2. Suspend the "Surrey County Council Raikes Lane (D274) Abinger Hammer Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022" in its entirety. This Traffic Order is required to enable BT Openreach to carry out tree-cutting and/or poling and/or cabling and/or ducting and/or maintenance works in the length of D274 Raikes Lane, between the southern side of its junction with C43 Abinger Lane, to the northern side of its junction with The Dene. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 9:30am and 3:30pm, within 1 day of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 23 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency vehicles, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Alternative route: - A25 Guildford Road and B2126 Horsham Road.
