Lower Guildford Road (D3605) Knaphill
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 22 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lower Guildford Road (D3605) Knaphill as extends from its junction with (C12) High Street and (C12) Anchor Hill and (D3620) Highclere Road to its junction with (D3607) Victoria Road. Alternative route – (A324) Hermitage Road, (A324) Amstel Way, (A324) Robin Hood Roundabout, Lockfield Drive, Littlewick Drive and Anchor Hill. This Order is required to carry out central Island essential works to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council and will commence on 31 March 2023 for a period of 18 months. These works are anticipated to be completed within 18 days, between the hours of 8am and 10pm. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians, dismounted cyclists and businesses. All other traffic including HGV's will be required to follow the alternative route described above. The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above, or accessible only therefrom, may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
