Notice Surrey County Council Ewhurst Road (B2127) Cranleigh Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 22 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Ewhurst Road (B2127) Cranleigh as extends from its junction with (D664) St Nicolas Avenue to its junction with (D188) New Park Road. Alternative Route- (B2127) Ewhurst Road, (B2127) Bookhurst Road, (B2127) Cranleigh Road, (C47) The Green, (C47) Somersbury Lane, (B2128) Horsham Road, and (B2127) Ewhurst Road or this route in reverse. This Order is required to carry out highway improvement works by or on behalf of Surrey County Council. These works are anticipated to be completed within 5 nights, between 7pm and 7am during the 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 01 April 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road, including access by emergency service vehicles to these properties, will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above.
