- 3. TQ1035 5581 TQ1021 5511 From Effingham Common Road to join route claimed at (2).
- TQ1035 5579 TQ1030 5522 From route claimed at (3), alongside Effingham
 Common Road then skirting cricket pitch to rejoin same route via TQ 1067 5536
 (the start of the route claimed at (1.)). Part of this route follows FP 114 (see Qu iii).


As suggested this application is for four routes as they are all in the same area and have been regularly used by all those who have submitted User Evidence Forms.

All four routes have been used regularly by horse riders since at least 1957 until the present day. The land which the routes cross was purchased by Guildford Borough Council in 2001/02 and regular use continued. In 2014/15 a cattle grid was installed across Route 3 at TQ1020 5511 and signage installed at TQ 1064 5536, 1026 5573, 1007 5503, 1008 5454, and 1033 5500 saying "No horse riding across the Common, please use the designated bridleways" with Permissive Bridleway finger posts where relevant. I have an email from a local councillor (copy attached) confirming that the cattle grid was installed to prevent horses crossing at that point which is further evidence of regular use by horse riders. Prior to these installations there were no barriers of any kind or signage relating to any users of the Commons.
