**Shipley Bridge Lane (C68) Shipley Bridge**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 16 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Shipley Bridge Lane (C68) Smallfield as extends from its junction with (B2037) Antlands Lane to a point in line with the southern boundary of the property known as "Boundary Edge".

Alternative Route – Antlands Lane; Keepers Corner; Copthorne Bank; and Shipley Bridge Lane or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 23 March 2022 for a period of 12 months is required because works are being, or are proposed to be, executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of BT Openreach, including but not limited to: telecoms poletest and/or new overhead fibre connection cabling and/or telecoms utility and maintenance works.

The works are anticipated to be carried out in two phases. The first phase is anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm commencing 23 March 2022. The second phase is anticipated to be carried out over 4 days between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm commencing 19 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected lengths of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by operatives on site as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
