Beddlestead Lane (C76) Warlingham and The Ridge (C75) Woldingham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 06 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding that length of:

- (a) Beddlestead Lane (C76) Warlingham as extends from its junction with (D453) Norheads Lane to its junction with (X45035) Pitchers Copse Farm.
Alternative Route – Beddlestead Lane; Clarks Lane; Limpsfield Road; Beech Farm Road; Hesiers Hill; and Beddlestead Lane or this same route in reverse.; and
- (b) The Ridge (C75) Woldingham as extends from its junction with (X35102) Southview Road to its junction with (D1454) The Ridge Car Park.
Alternative Route – The Ridge; Limpsfield Road; Slines Oak Road; Halliloo Valley Road; Woldingham Road; Station Road; Northdown Road; and The Ridge or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 11 April 2022 for a period of 12 months is required because works are being, or are proposed to be, executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of BT Openreach, including but not limited to: overhead fibre cabling and/or overhead utility cabling and/or telecoms pole replacement and/or new telecoms fibre connection and/or telecoms pole installation and/or telecoms utility maintenance works. For part (a) works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 days between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm. For part (b) works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected lengths of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by operatives on site as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.
