The Surrey County Council D182 Alfold Road, Cranleigh

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 18 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D182 Alfold Road, Cranleigh that extends from the northern side of its junction with Lorimer Avenue, to the north-eastern property boundary of "Beggars Roost". This Traffic Order is required to enable Morrison Utility Services to carry out water mains replacement and/or connection and/or maintenance works on behalf of Thames Water/Agility Alliance. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 8 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 23 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated to be required for 24 hours each day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for emergency services, residents and businesses will be maintained at all times via the vehicular diversion routes: - Route 1. Alfold Road, Elmbridge Road, Horsham Road, Alfold Bypass and Alfold Road. Route 2. Alfold Road, Alfold Bypass, Horsham Road, Elmbridge Road and Alfold Road.
