D1000 Ruden Way, Epsom Downs
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 11 January 2023 Surrey County Council made above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D1000 Ruden Way, Epsom Downs. This Traffic Order is required to enable water mains and/or foul sewer connection and/or maintenance works in the length of D1000 Ruden Way, that extends between the south-eastern property boundary of “No.127 Ruden Way”, to the north-eastern property boundary of “No.133 Ruden Way”, on behalf of Fleet Homes. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 4 weeks of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 20 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated to be required for 24 hours each day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for residents and businesses and emergency services will be maintained to the point of closure via the vehicular diversion route: - Ruden Way, Reigate Road, Fir Tree Road and Ruden Way.
