Hamlash Lane (D114) Frensham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Hamlash Lane (D114) Frensham which extends from with a point in line with the southern boundary of the property known as “Mulberry House” to its junction with (D113) Fifield Lane. Alternative Route- Fifield Lane, Shortfield Common Road and Hamlash Lane or this route in reverse. This Order is required to carry out installation of new track, box and chamber works by or on behalf of Swish Fibre. These works are anticipated to be completed within 10 days, between 7am and 6pm during the 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 06 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road, including access by emergency service vehicles to these properties, will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above.
