The Surrey County Council Whyteleafe Hill (C227) Whyteleafe Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 08 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Whyteleafe Hill (C227) Whyteleafe that is crossed by the level crossing known as "Whyteleafe Level Crossing" and for a distance of 20 meters on either side. Alternative Route – (C227) Whyteleafe Hill, (C227) Whyteleafe Road, (D1402) Burtwood Lane, (A22) Wapses Lodge roundabout and (A22) Godstone Road or this route in reverse. The Order is required to facilitate accessing RRV and removal of scrap metal and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 12.30am and 4am within the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 26 March 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for emergency services, residents and businesses will be maintained via the vehicular diversion route. No sole access to any property will be affected.
