The Chase (D2531) Ashtead
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 08 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of The Chase (D2531) Ashtead as extends from a point in line with the south western boundary of No.12 The Chase to a point in line with the north eastern boundary of No.14 The Chase.

Alternative Route – Oakhill Road; and Green Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of ASL Civil Engineers Ltd within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 8 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 13 December 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
