Pook Hill (D157) Chiddingfold
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 23 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Pook Hill (D157) Chiddingfold as extends from its junction with (D154) Prestwick Lane to its junction with the access to the properties known as "Langhurst Manor".

Alternative Route – Pook Hill; West End Lane; Killinghurst Lane; A283 Petworth Road; Coxcombe Lane; Ridgley Road; Combe Lane; and Prestwick Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms piling and/or cabling and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 31 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
