Bridgefield (D5327) Farnham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 06 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Bridgefield (D5327) Farnham as extends from a point in line with the shared boundary between No. 39 and No.39A Bridgefield to a point in line with the shared boundary between No. 41 and No. 43 Bridgefield.

There is no applicable alternative route.

The Order is required to allow telecoms pole replacement works and/or cabling and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 12 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
