Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 11 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic (including pedestrians and cyclists) from entering or proceeding in that length of D343 Russells Crescent, Horley that extends from its junction with C64 Victoria Road, for a distance of 20m. This Traffic Order is required to enable Surrey County Council to carry out traffic signal refurbishment and/or highway resurfacing and/or improvement and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible within 11 days of the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 16 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated to be required for 24 hours each day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained via the footway to Victoria Road and Consort Way East. Access for emergency services, residents and businesses will be maintained via the vehicular diversion route: - Russells Crescent, Massetts Road and Victoria Road. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
