Burgh Wood (D1009) Banstead
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 22 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Burgh Wood (D1009) Banstead as extends its junction with (D1013) Brighton Road Service Road between Burgh Wood and Tattenham Way to a point in line with the common boundary between No.2 and No.4 Burgh Wood. **Alternative Route –** Burgh Wood, Hillside, Green Curve, East Gate, Nork Way, Fir Tree Road, Brighton Road, and Burgh Road or this route in reverse. This Order is required to facilitate lead replacement works for or on behalf of SES Water. These works are anticipated to be completed over 5 days between the hours of 8.30am and 5pm within 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 03 April 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to maintain vehicular access through the closure, and all vehicular traffic, including the emergency services will be required to use the signed diversion route.
